

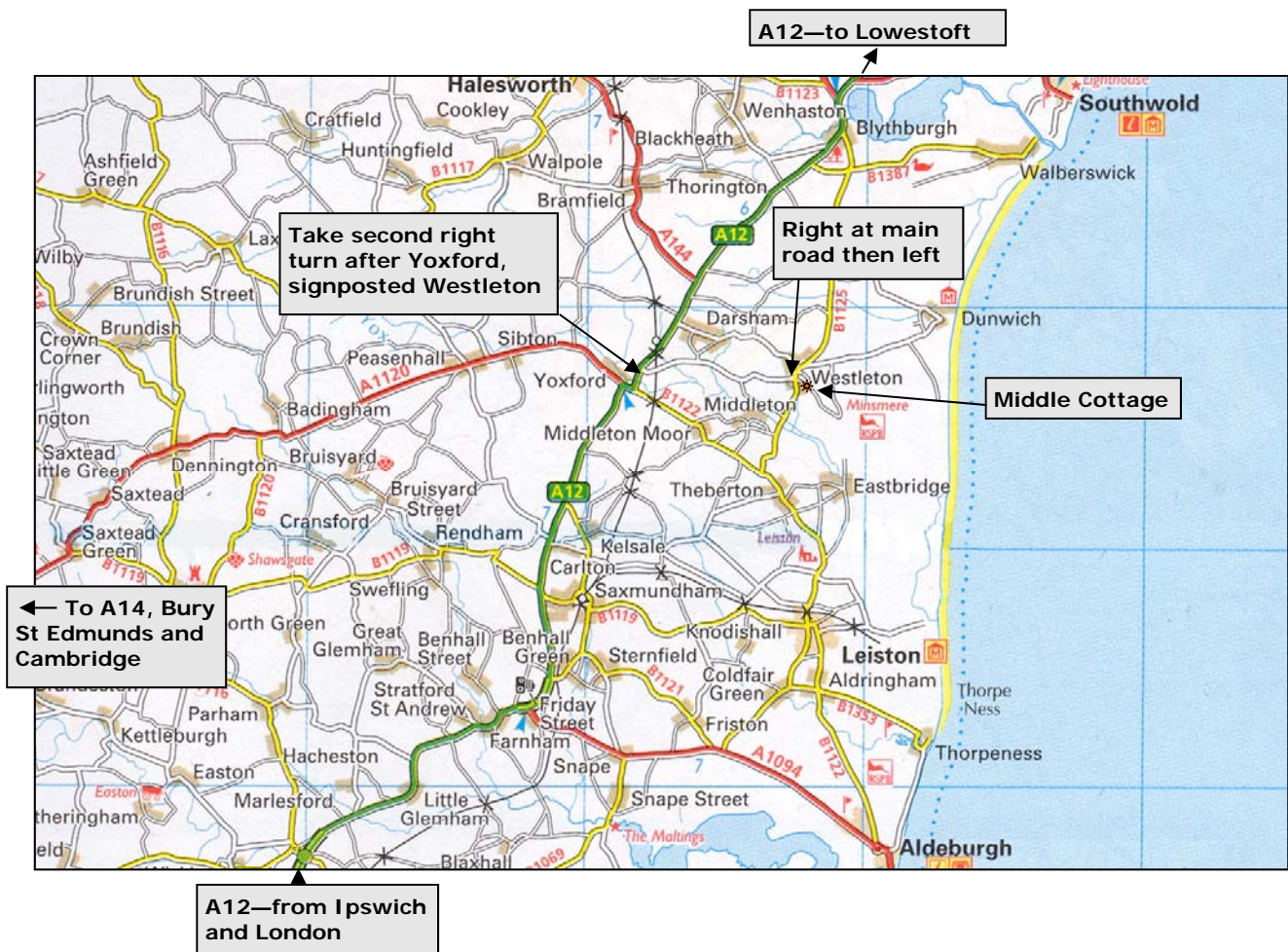
# DIRECTIONS TO MIDDLE COTTAGE

Middle Cottage, Mill Street, Westleton, Saxmundham, Suffolk IP17 3BD

## DIRECTIONS– From London and the south

If you are driving up the A12 from the London direction you will pass turnings to Chelmsford and Colchester. Just to the south of Ipswich you will reach a large roundabout with traffic lights. On the other side of the roundabout you can see a big Toys R Us store. Turn right at this roundabout by taking the third exit, signposted Felixstowe A14 and Lowestoft A12. This is the Ipswich bypass. The road takes you across a long bridge over the River Orwell. Stay on the A14 for another couple of miles after the bridge and then take a left exit marked A12 for Lowestoft and Woodbridge. Stay on the A12 through a series of roundabouts and keep following the signs for Lowestoft. You will pass turnings for



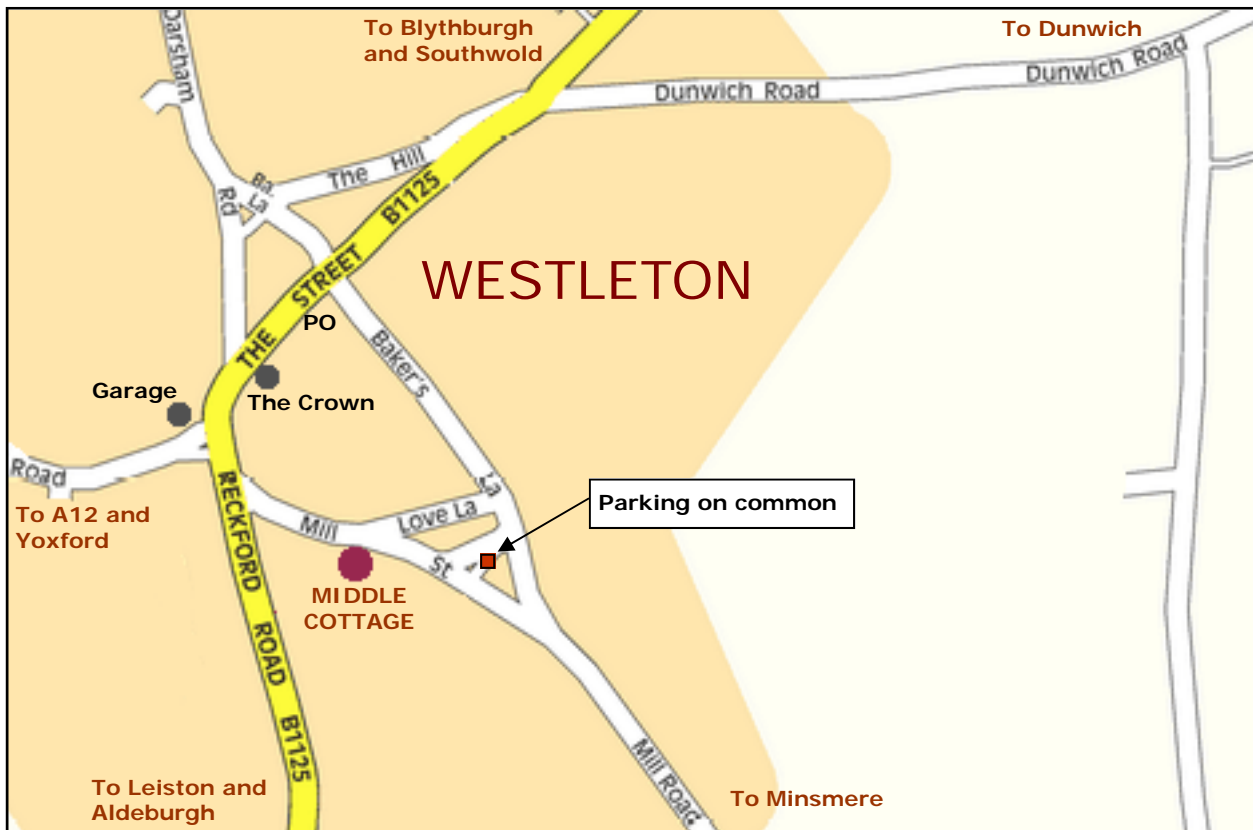
Woodbridge, Aldeburgh and Saxmundham. About 20 miles from the point at which you left the Ipswich bypass you will come to the village of YOXFORD. Just north of the village there is a turning on the right to Leiston. Keep on the A12 past this junction and take the next turning on the right (signposted to **Westleton, Dunwich and The Crown**). After about two miles you will come to a T-junction with Westleton's main street ('The Street'). Turn right into the main road and then almost immediately left into Mill Street where it says 'Unsuitable for Coaches'. Middle Cottage is 100 yards along on the right, the third in a terrace of four cottages.

## DIRECTIONS – From the north

If you are coming from the north, fork left off the A12 just after the White Hart Inn at Blythburgh, (signposted Westleton). After about four miles you will come to the village of Westleton. Mill Street is the first turning on the left after The Crown. Middle Cottage is 100 yards along on the right, the third in a terrace of four cottages.

## DIRECTIONS – From Cambridge and the west via the A14 and the A1120

Follow the A14 past the turnings for Bury St Edmund's and Stowmarket. Just after the Stowmarket turn take the left junction and at the roundabout follow the road marked A1120 and Yoxford. Keep on this pleasant and winding country road for some 20 miles until it joins the A12 at Yoxford. Turn left onto the A12 going north towards Lowestoft. Then take the second main road to the right,



signposted Westleton, Dunwich and The Crown. After about two miles you will come to a T-junction with Westleton's main street ('The Street'). Turn right into the main road and then almost immediately left into Mill Street where it says 'Unsuitable for Coaches'. Middle Cottage is 100 yards along on the right, the third in a terrace of four cottages. □
